Program Information

Achieve! Christian Academy homeschool class registration is now open for high school students!! Classes meet one time per week for 32 weeks where the director presents the material, answers student questions, facilitates class discussion to develop critical thinking skills, assigns work for the student to complete at home for the remainder of the week and encourages students and parents through their high school homeschool journey. All classes are taught through a biblical worldview. Students have an opportunity to earn 7 full high school credits.

FEES (per student):

Registration Fee: \$125 per year
Supply Fee \$100 per year
Tuition: \$1,800 per year (\$900 per semester)

The registration fee and supply fee will both need to be paid to hold your child's seat. Your child(ren) will not be considered enrolled until both the registration and supply fees have been paid in full. Class size is limited and will be filled on a first-come, first-paid basis. First semester tuition will need to be paid by Friday, September 3rd. Second Semester tuition is due by January 4th, 2022. Director reserves the right to decline enrollment of any student for any reason.

In addition to the above fees, students must have their own books for the above courses to be used in class. A list of required books and supplies is printed on a separate schedule, along with suggested options of where to purchase.

PAYMENT TERMS

You are contractually obligated to pay the entire semester's tuition even if you leave the program mid-semester. The first semester is due by Friday, September 3rd and second semester tuition is due by January 4th, 2022. Students will not be allowed to attend class unless tuition has been

paid in full, unless a payment plan has been established. If the parent is more than 2 weeks behind on the payment plan, the student(s) will not be allowed to attend until payments are current.

PAYMENT PLAN

We understand that parents may not have the entire balance available to pay the tuition in full at time of enrollment, especially during these times of uncertainty. Therefore, Achieve! Christian Academy will allow a payment plan for any family who needs to use it. Please note the payment plan is for tuition only, the registration fee and supply fee are not eligible to be paid under the payment plan and will need to be paid at time of enrollment. The payment plan will have a \$25 per month finance charge applied for use of the payment plan. An additional \$25 late fee will be applied to any monthly payment that is not paid by the 5th of that month.

If the tuition is paid in full prior to the next months due date, the next months (and any subsequent months') Finance Charge(s) will not be due. Ex: Tuition is paid in full for the first semester on October 25th, 2021. There will be no Finance Charge fees due for the November and December payments, for a savings of \$50.00.

Please keep in mind that the cost of our rigorous high school academy is very modest compared to other private schools. We value homeschool parents and their commitment to a Christian education at home.

REFUNDS

Registration fees and supply fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. The Director may refund a portion of your pre-paid tuition if a new student is able to take your place **and** if the student leaves in good standing. Students asked to leave due to conduct issues or other problematic issues as determined at the Director's discretion will not be refunded.

EXPECTATIONS

Achieve! Christian Academy expects its students, parents, and staff to treat each other with honor and respect. Students are expected to come to class prepared and with a great attitude, take notes and be active participants. Students are expected to do the work to the best of their ability.

This is a one-day drop off program, but not a drop-out program. Parents are expected to assist the student as needed at home, to confirm that all work has been completed to the best of the students' ability prior to class and to communicate with both the student and Director as needed.

5. I understand if a conflict arises, I will speak directly to the person(s) the conflict involves and do my best to resolve it between the conflicted parties. If it involves the Director or if a conflict or behavior issue occurs during class, and if necessary, I (and/or my student) will agree to a conflict resolution plan whenever possible. Major conflicts could result in immediate or a delayed dismissal if the Director determines the conflict to be serious in nature and a positive resolution would not be possible or feasible.
6. I understand that classes are held in the private home of the Director and her family. The student and parents, siblings, etc. picking the child up are to respect the privacy and home of the Director and family. The student (and all visitors) are to remain in the classroom at all times, unless directed otherwise. Students use of the bathroom, kitchen and dining room are permitted before and after class, during lunch and with permission from the Director. The student and visitors must respect privacy and not open any cabinet or closet doors, drawers, etc. unless instructed by the Director to do so. Students are permitted to use the microwave in the kitchen to reheat their lunch.
